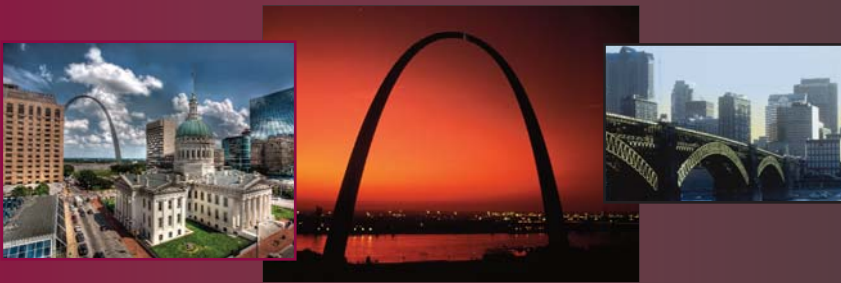

Instructions:

A check payable to IACLEA Annual Conference, or copy of approved purchase order or credit card authorization for registration fees (or any combination) MUST accompany the form. Correct fees must be received at IACLEA for an attendee to be registered. All registration fees must be paid in U.S. dollars.
2. Your name and institution will appear exactly as you indicate on this form.
3. Print or type all information.
4. Make copies of this form for any additional persons who wish to register. Send a separate form for each registration.

Registration Policies:

1. Only individuals registered and badged may attend conference events. Note spouse/guest name on the Delegate Registration Form if an additional badge is requested. Children need badges so include their names.
2. No registration may be processed without payment or receipt of a purchase order. For registration purposes, an institution's purchase order will be treated as cash.
3. Payment or purchase order must accompany the Registration Form in order to receive the early registration discount.

St. Louis, Missouri

St. Louis, Missouri, hailed as the Gateway to the West, has a rich history and offers many attractions. Transportation to and from the Airport

There are several options for ground transportation to and from the Airport. The taxi fee is about \$45 each way. A light rail train system connects the main and east terminals of the Airport to the downtown area. There is also a shuttle service available at the Airport. Details:

Metrolink

A light rail train system connecting the main and east terminals of Lambert International Airport to the downtown area. Hyatt Regency St. Louis at the Arch guests can exit at 8th and Pine Street (hotel is at 4th and Pine St.) just minutes from the hotel. Total travel time is approximately 27-30 minutes. The trains run approximately every 30 minutes from 5:02 a.m. to 12:48 a.m.

Cost: \$3.50 to / from airport. Not recommended for people with heavy or large amounts of luggage as there is a short walk to the hotel. *All other rides on the METROLINK are \$2 each way. Metrolink tickets are sold at each stop.
