Campus Public Safety Response to WMD Incidents AWR124-W

This course prepares campus public safety personnel to become more proficient in the management of emergencies caused by Weapons of Mass Destruction (WMD). The content addresses emergency preparedness and security measures that will help higher education campus public safety personnel to better prepare for terrorism or WMD events.

Topics covered in this course include:

- Introduction to Terrorism
- Weapons of Mass Destruction
- Multi-Agency Response
- Personal Protection and Safety
- Strategies and Tactics

The content of this course is an adaptation of material used in a traditional face-to-face awareness-level training course developed for campus public safety personnel by Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College (LSU) and the International Association of Campus Law Enforcement Administrators (IACLEA).
