

## Canadian Member Appointed to Accreditation Commission

The IACLEA Board of Directors appointed Dan Redmond, Director of Campus Community Police Service at Western University in London, Ontario, Canada, to IACLEA's Accreditation Commission during its February 23 meeting. Director Redmond succeeds John Carson both as leader of campus public safety services at

Western University and as international representative on IACLEA's Accreditation Commission.

Redmond, former Chief Superintendent and Regional Commander for the Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) East Region, was appointed Director-Elect for Western University on October 11, 2016, and took over the top post on January 1, 2017. Redmond has more than 30 years of progressive experience across the province and overseas with the OPP. As Chief Superintendent and Regional Commander, he supervised 1,200 uniform and civilian members, while overseeing a \$110 million budget. Most recently, he was OPP's Senior Officer in charge for the 2016 North American

Leaders' Summit in Ottawa, directing more than 2,000 officers and staff. His international experience includes acting as Senior Advisor to the Chief of a United Nations mission investigating terrorist activities in Beirut, Lebanon.

In recommending Redmond's appointment, Jessica Luedtke, Chair of IACLEA's Accreditation Commission and Assistant Director of Public Safety at the Medical College of Wisconsin, noted, "We are very grateful for John Carson's energetic support of IACLEA's Accreditation Program and his thoughtful guidance as a commission member. We are committed to ensuring that our Canadian and international members continue to be represented on the commission. Dan Redmond's willingness to serve will assure the commission's ongoing effort to broadly and thoroughly address best professional practices for all campus public safety."

Currently, Western University is the only Canadian institution with an accredited public safety department. However, there are four other agencies, three in Alberta and one in Ontario, under contract with IACLEA and in self-assessment.

The Accreditation Commission consists of twelve volunteers, nine of whom are IACLEA members appointed by the president and confirmed by the Board. The three additional members are drawn from allied associations, including a business officer, appointed by the National Association of College and University Business Officers; a student affairs officer, appointed by the National Association of Student Personnel Administrators; and a representative of the National Association of College and University Attorneys.
