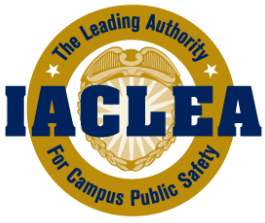

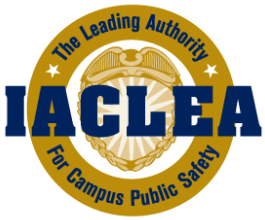
Transportation
